Griffith University is recognised as one of Australia's most innovative and dynamic public universities, located in the nation's fastest growth region, the Brisbane-Gold Coast corridor.

- Griffith has a student population of 37,786 students studying one across 268 undergraduate or 382 postgraduate degree programs.
- Griffith has been ranked in the top 4 per cent of the World's universities according to the Times HE-QS World University Rankings and is Australia's 9th largest higher education institution by student load (in 2007).
- In 2008, Griffith was placed in tenth position overall among Australian universities for research publications (indexed in the Thomson Reuters Web of Science) and in seventh position for papers published in the Social Science Citation Index.
